

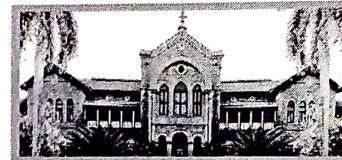

Important Circular Mandatory Non-Credit Course (MNC) Post-Graduate Programs (Arts/ Science)

As per SPPU circular no. 294/2023, Under NEP2020, all Post Graduate Streams should incorporate Human Rights, Introduction to Cyber /Information Security and Skill Development as **Mandatory Non-Credit (MNC) Courses of 10 credits** in their curriculum. Below mentioned is the structure of the MNC courses.
