**Admission Process**

1. Student must be admitted for First Year B. A. / B. Sc. / B. Voc. in the Fergusson College.
2. Student must be enrolled to the Cultural department of Fergusson College.
3. Student must be an active participant for Cultural department.
4. Selection will be based on Auditions and to previous experience of performance at different competitions (Inter-collegiate, State, National).
