Two foreign Languages, German and French are offered for FYBAat two levels namely, Basic and Advanced.

- Following courses are offered at FYBA level.
 - 1. FYBA French Basic (Beginners)
 - 2. FYBA French Advanced (Non beginners)
 - 3. FYBA German Basic (Beginners)
 - 4. FYBA German Advanced (Non beginners)
- Students who have learnt German or French at the junior college level (i.e.11th and 12th std) are supposed to opt for the advanced level.
- Students without prior knowledge of German or French are supposed to opt for Basic level.
- For basic level (German and French) students need to pay Rs.2,500/-as additional fees

Rules for choice of subjects for F.Y. B.A. Grant-in-Aid (Division A, B & C):

- 1. A student has to study 6 subjects in all.
- 2. Compulsory English is a Compulsory paper. Hence a student needs to select 5 other papers.
- 3. Student can opt for only ONE subject from EACHgroup.
- 4. Out of the 5 subjects, students have to select minimum one Language (second language), but not more than ONE from any given languagegroup. Optional English can be taken as a Second language.
- 5. Students wanting to study English (Special) at S.Y.B.A. **MUST**opt for Optional English at F.Y.B.A.
- 6. The students who want to specialize in Economics in S.Y. B.A. are advised to opt for Financial Mathematics in F.Y. B.A.
- 7. No change of subject will be allowed after admission.
- 8. Physical Training (PT) is compulsory for first year students. Students will have to strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the PT Department/CollegeGymkhana.

Rules for F.Y. B.A. Self-Finance (Division D):

- 1. A student has to study 6 subjects in all.
- 2. No provision for choice of subjects.
- 3. Physical Training (PT) is compulsory for first year students. Students will have to strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the PT Department/College Gymkhana.

General Points to be Noted:

- •For F.Y. B.A. all the 6 subjects are offered at 'General' level. However, during S.Y. B.A. admission (based on F.Y. academic performance), the student is eligible to specialise ONLY in a subject that she/he had opted for in F.Y. B.A.
- •The students who wish to take Mathematics Special in S.Y. B.A. should **compulsorily** opt for all three Mathematics courses at F.Y. B.A. Calculus, Algebra and Financial Mathematics.
- •Kindly follow the path given below and go through the syllabi of the respective subjects before selection through admission form fergusson.edu => Academics => Curriculum => Revised Syllabi June 2019 => First Year Syllabus
