Minutes of the Meeting

The 7th Academic Council Meeting was held on the 16th July, 2020 on Microsoft Teams online platform.

Principal Dr. Ravindrasing Pardeshi, Principal and Chairman, Academic Council welcomed the members and appreciated that the meeting is being held on the online platform in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic and related restrictions.

1. Dr. Samir Terdalkar carried out the Confirmation of minutes of 6th Academic Council by sharing the details with the Members.

2. Dr. Nitin Kulkarni, Vice-Principal, Science informed the members about the rationale for changing examination pattern from 100 marks to 50 marks - i.e. CE-50% and ESE (50%) for all Undergraduate Programmes, with effect from academic year 2020-2021.
3. Mandatory credits for B.A. and B.Sc. degree should be reduced from 12 to 8 as per the guidelines of Savitribai Phule Pune University (Rules and Regulations for UG Choice Based Credit System for Science Programme under Faculty of Science and Technology) effective from June 2019. Prof. Saroj Ghaskadbi shared her views elaborately on the credit system that actually gave an insight into the credit system to all the members.
4. Approval of Revised Course Structure of B. A. Programme with effect from year 2019-2020.
Dr. Chitra Sreedharan, Member Governing Body, shared the details of the Choice Based Credit System for B.A. and explained how 132 credits are being calculated for B.A. Programmes.
5. Implementation of Compulsory 2-credit course on "Democracy, Election and Governance" for all First year B.A., B.Sc. and B.Voc. programs from 2020-2021.
Dr. Samir Terdalkar shared that the syllabus and the readings of the course have been given by SPPU and that we are supposed to implement it from this academic year. He requested the members to guide us on how to go about the course. Dr. Hrishikesh Soman asked whether it was compulsory for Autonomous colleges as well. Dr. Ravindrasing Pardeshi replied that the Vice Chancellor had mentioned it to be so in a meeting held in October or November 2019. Dr. Hrishikesh Soman said that earlier the EVA (Environmental Awareness) was made compulsory due to a ruling of the Supreme Court. We have to conduct it after college hours. Physical Training (PT) is compulsory. We have to hold PT before college hours. As autonomous colleges we should be able to opt out saying that it does not fit into the daily schedule. Dr. Ravindrasing Pardeshi said that it would have to be fitted in after college hours. Dr. Hrishikesh Soman added that it will be a repetition for Arts students. Shri. Prakash Pawar replied that all Arts students do not offer Political Science. There are many options in Fergusson College (Autonomous) for Arts students to choose their subjects. Dr. Hrishikesh Soman asked whether we can request Prof. Kumbhar who is the VC Nominee / University Representative to please cross check for us. He also added that we should take a consolidated decision for all Autonomous colleges. It was decided to communicate this issue with the University and ask for their guidance in this regard.
6. Dr. Samir Terdalkar shared the information about the implementation of the guidelines from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, University Grants Commission and Savitribai Phule Pune University regarding ONLINE Teaching and learning methods to be adopted in view of Covid19 pandemic. He mentioned that we have already started online teaching for postgraduate courses. We are following all the guidelines and working at implementing the same. All the teachers are taking efforts towards this end. They are developing e-Content for their upcoming classes. It was appreciated by the members.
