

Information about admission in Bifocal course and Information Technology :

About Bifocal Course at Fergusson College :

For Bifocal course, student can take one bifocal subject of 200 marks in place of Biology/Geography and Second Language. For Bifocal subject, Mathematics is compulsory.

In Bifocal, there are 2 papers of 100 marks each. For each paper theory is of 50 marks and Practical is of 50 marks.

In Fergusson College, aided means Grantable(G) Bifocal as well as unaided means Non-Grantable (NG), **Bifocal courses** are available.

** GTHS means Government Technical High School, Ghole Road
Lectures of Grantable Bifocal subjects will be conducted by GTHS teachers at GTHS and remaining subjects will be conducted at Fergusson college by Fergusson teachers.

Admission Procedure for Bifocal course or Information Technology :

- The admissions of Bifocal course and Information Technology will be done as per the directives of Centralized Admission Committee.
- The admission to the Bifocal courses will be given at Junior College level as per the merit. The students who have taken admission through general and special rounds can participate in the admission process of bifocal course.(Ref.- Centralized online admission process Information Booklet page no.17)
- Also the subject "Information Technology" will be given to students on merit basis after all rounds of college admissions are over.
- While completing admission process, a student has to choose six subjects initially and make the payment for college fees.
- Later if student gets admission in bifocal course, he/she will drop two optional subjects selected initially. Note that **for bifocal course Mathematics is compulsory.**
- Also later if a student gets Information Technology subject, he/she will drop one optional subject.(Student cannot opt for bifocal and IT simultaneously.)

- Student taking bifocal course or IT, will have to pay separate fees for the same.
