ADMISSION PROCESS

- 1. Student must be admitted for First Year B.A /BSc. In the Fergusson College
- 2. Student must be enrolled to National Cadet Corps either Army wing, Naval Wing of Fergusson College, or any other Open Units of NCC under Pune NCC Group.
- 3. If student has not been selected for NCC, he can still opt NCC as a Co-Curricular Course for the academic year 2023-2024.
- 4. Selection for NCC will be based on Physical Test, Written Test, Interview at College Unit Level and then on Battalion Level.
