

FOR B.Voc in INTERIOR DESIGN

Department History

INTERIOR DESIGNING & DECORATION (IDD) was started in DE's JRVGTI in the year 1986 to train students in Interior design. This course was initiated by Deccan Education Society as a self-financed, Autonomous & part time course under VGTI Unit. Now this year Fergusson college, Pune has introduced B.VOC. in INTERIOR DESIGN (Autonomous) after approval of UGC.

Looking at the changing trend, college has decided to modify and tailor the courses under University Grand Commission (UGC) in line with NSQF (National Skill Qualification framework). The National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) is a competency-based framework that organizes all qualifications according to a series of levels of knowledge, skills and aptitude.

Students of the vocational course are more privileged due to their vocational training along with conventional knowledge-based curriculum. This fact is considered while framing the syllabus. Proper emphasis is given on the theoretical component vis-à-vis its application keeping up the academic foundation.

Programme highlights

This is a 3-year Degree Program with the exists as per the New Education Policy. After 1st semester students can get a Certificate, after 2nd semesters a Diploma, after 4th semesters Advanced Diploma and after 6th semesters a complete B.Voc in Interior Design Degree under Fergusson College, Pune (Autonomous) & Savitribai Phule Pune University. The idea is very clear that after every two semesters the student should be industry-ready with at least two Interior related skills along with professional and ethical understanding of that specific vertical of the Interior industry. Also, these Programs will be very useful for people of any age who are already working in this field but with less formal education. The B. Voc. Programme is a credit-based programme with a total of 180 credit points over a span of three years. (60 credit points per year.) The programme is run with two components, the General Education component, and the Skilled component.

Objectives of B.Voc in Interior Design

1. To provide in-depth knowledge of theory & execution.
2. To familiarize with current and recent industry trends.
3. To enrich knowledge through programmes such as Industrial visits, Study tour, Exhibition projects, Market survey, Projects, Elevation (Interaction with renowned Architects & Interior Designer) etc.
4. To train students in skills related to Interior industry and market.
5. To develop design abilities towards design projects.
6. To help student's build-up a progressive and successful career in Interior Design.
7. To promote the possibility of self-employment by providing skill-based training.
8. To bridge the gap between knowledge based conventional education and market demands and to provide an alternative to those pursuing higher education.

Eligibility

The students passing 10+2 or equivalent can apply for this course.
